Laghetto (sub)alpino con annessa piccola torbiera che occupa il fondo dell'antico circo glaciale a nord del M. Ziolera sulla catena porfirica del Lagorai. Sono presenti habitat di particolare interesse non compresi nell'all. I della direttiva 92/43/CEE, in particolare: *Caricetalia fuscae* (5%).

4.2 Quality and importance

Apprezzabile vegetazione idrofittica di acque fredde oligotrofiche; la vicina piccola torbiera ospita alcune specie paludicole di un certo interesse. Si tratta di un biotopo di vitale importanza per la riproduzione di molte specie di anfibi e rettili.
