Other Site Characteristics

Numerosi rinvenimenti di resti di stambecco e cervo e rari manufatti litici del Mesolitico. Cavità riccamente concrezionata, anche con formazioni fossili. Numerose specie animali frequentano o svernano nella cavità.

4.2 Quality and importance

La cavità si apre a m 1167 slm., in una formazione di Calcari Grigi, lungo un ripido versante che presenta una falda detritica ora completamente vegetata. La morfologia originale si è modificata per fenomeni di crollo e da numerose concrezioni parietali. Presenza di vaschette concrezionali soggette a forti oscillazioni stagionali di portata.
