Grotta di rilevante interesse ambientale e faunistico ad elevato grado di integrità ecologica. La cavità è tipica di tre specie di invertebrati. Sono comuni veli e piccoli depositi di guano.

### 4.2 Quality and importance

Cavità costituita da un'unica grande galleria, con apertura a m 1710 slm, nella formazione della Dolomia Principale. Morfologia originale modificata o distrutta da crolli. La cavità è praticamente fossile e non si osservano stalagmiti e colate attive. Presenti due pozzi laterali in cui si sono rinvenuti resti ossei di stambecco. Vegetazione di larici, abeti rossi, carpino, che si dirada causa acclività.
