### Other Site Characteristics

Il sito comprende la catena porfirica compresa tra il Passo Valles e il Passo Lusia e il suo regolare versante meridionale fino al Torrente Travignolo nonché il tratto della catena porfirica del Lagorai a est di Forcella Cece fino a Passo Rolle, il sottogruppo dello Scanaiol, la Valsorda e l'alta Valzanca. La pecceta sfuma in alto nella cembreta, sopra la quale si stendono le praterie alpine e gli ambienti di cresta e di vetta. Sono presenti alcune malghe, in parte ancora monticate. Alcuni laghi alpini contribuiscono ad arricchire il paesaggio. Sono presenti habitat di particolare interesse per la direttiva 92/43/CEE, in particolare quelli relativi alle formazioni d'alta quota, erbacei e rupestri..

### 4.2 Quality and importance

Classico ambiente alpino su silice, in generale poco antropizzato e sostanzialmente integro. A ciò si aggiunge un buon contingente di rarità floristiche. Il sito è di rilevante interesse nazionale e/o provinciale per la presenza e la riproduzione di specie animali in via di estinzione, importanti relitti glaciali, esclusive e/o tipiche delle Alpi. Elevati pregi legati alla spiccata naturalità della maggior parte dei settori della zona, a tutt'oggi assai poco antropizzata, se si escludono alcune zone interessate da impianti di tipo sciistico. Notevole il numero di rarità floristiche e di paesaggi vegetali "classici" dell'ambiente alpino su substrato siliceo. Presenza di invertebrati indicatori di boschi con buone caratteristiche di naturalità.
